



Energy Safety to Hold Virtual Public Workshop on Utility Data Submission Portal

The Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety (Energy Safety) will hold a virtual public meeting on its Utility Data Submission Portal (UDSP), Tuesday, June 30, 2026, from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. The virtual workshop will feature a demo of the UDSP and provide an opportunity for the public to offer feedback.

The UDSP was first mentioned in Data Guidelines version 4.1 and will be required for tabular data submissions starting on August 1, 2026 and as the primary data submission mechanism on November 1, 2026. At this meeting, Energy Safety will present an overview of the changes to the process and take public comment. Following this presentation, the UDSP will be made publicly available in a testing mode, and all regulated parties will be encouraged to create accounts and test validations in a controlled environment to give feedback to Energy Safety.
