Energy Safety Draft Decisions on SDG&E and SCE's 2022 Wildfire Mitigation Plan Updates

The Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety (Energy Safety) will hold a virtual public meeting on **May 26, 2022**, on its Draft Decisions on San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) and Southern California Edison Company's (SCE's) 2022 Wildfire Mitigation Plan (WMP) Updates.¹ This meeting will allow Energy Safety to present an overview of its findings, including areas of progress and areas for continued improvement. Following the presentations from Energy Safety staff there will be time for public comment and discussion on the Draft Decisions.

Energy Safety invites stakeholders, including individual members of the public and local and regional agencies, boards, tribes, and commissions, to participate in this public meeting on the Draft Decisions. Furthermore, Energy Safety will be accepting written public comments on the Draft Decisions once they are published.²
