The discussion will include the process and requirements for facility abandonment, required records and record maintenance of abandoned facilities, notification practices, and transfers of ownership of an abandoned facility to local agencies. There will be an opportunity for public comment for items not on the agenda.

Members of the public, stakeholders, local and regional agencies, boards, tribes, and commissions are invited to participate in the discussion and public comment. Energy Safety is also accepting written public comments prior to the public meeting.
