ADOPTION MEETING FOR 2023-2025 WILDFIRE MITIGATION PLAN GUIDELINES

The Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety (Energy Safety) will hold a public meeting on December 6, 2022, for the adoption of the 2023-2025 Wildfire Mitigation Plan (WMP) Guidelines. Energy Safety will take public comment, present an overview of the changes, and consider adoption of the 2023-2025 WMP Guidelines. The documents to be discussed are:
