To: Stakeholders for Electrical Undergrounding Plan Guidelines

Subject: Draft Electrical Undergrounding Plan Guidelines

The Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety releases the attached Draft Electrical Undergrounding Plan Guidelines for public review and comment.

Senate Bill 884 (McGuire; Stats. 2022, Ch. 819) directed that an expedited utility distribution infrastructure undergrounding program be established. The California Public Utilities Commission established the program on March 7, 2024. To participate in the program, a large electrical corporation must submit a 10-year plan to the Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety (Energy Safety) for review and approval that meets certain statutory requirements. The Draft Electrical Undergrounding Plan Guidelines contain the procedural and substantive requirements that must be met to submit an Electrical Undergrounding Plan for review and approval.

## **Public Comments**

Written opening comments must be submitted no later than May 29, 2024. Reply comments must be submitted no later than June 10, 2024. The written comments must be filed in the Energy Safety efiling- system to the EUP Guideline Development docket (2023-UPs). Opening comments must be no more than 30 pages and reply comments must be no more than 15 pages. Supporting documents may be included as appendices or attachments and are excluded from the page limits.

## **Public Workshop**

Energy Safety will present the Draft Electrical Undergrounding Plan Guidelines at a public workshop on May 15, 2024, and a follow-up workshop on May 22, 2024. Energy Safety will provide information on how to participate in the workshops, as well as agendas in advance of the workshop dates.
