Ms. Swenson:

PacifiCorp submitted its 2025 Wildfire Mitigation Plan Update (2025 WMP Update) and revised 2023-2025 Base Wildfire Mitigation Plan (2023-2025 Base WMP) (redlined and clean versions) to the Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety's (Energy Safety) 2023-2025 WMPs docket on July 8, 2024.¹ PacifiCorp submitted a revision of each per Energy Safety's Rejection and Order to Resubmit to the same docket on September 20, 2024. Following PacifiCorp's resubmission, Energy Safety identified substantive and non-substantive errors that remain for PacifiCorp to correct.

All changes to PacifiCorp's approved 2023-2025 Base WMP (i.e., Revision #2) and to its initially filed 2025 WMP Update (i.e., Revision #0), both identified and not identified in this request for errata, must be depicted in redline. All new text must be underlined and removed text must be in strikeout.

PacifiCorp must revise its 2025 WMP Update and 2023-2025 Base WMP to correct the substantive and non-substantive errors identified in Appendix A, herein. PacifiCorp must submit its Revised 2025 WMP Update and Revised 2023-2025 Base WMP to Energy Safety's 2023-2025 WMPs docket by January 17, 2025.

If PacifiCorp makes corrections to its 2025 WMP Update and 2023-2025 Base WMP beyond those in Appendix A, it must provide a list of each correction in its cover letter that will accompany its response to this Notice on Errata.
