ADOPTION MEETING FOR THE WILDFIRE MITIGATION PLAN GUIDELINES – PACKAGE 1

The Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety (Energy Safety) will hold a public meeting on February 21, 2025, for the adoption of the Wildfire Mitigation Plan (WMP) Guidelines. This meeting will be remote only. Energy Safety will take public comment, present an overview of changes to the WMP Guidelines, and consider adoption of the WMP Guidelines – Package 1. Specific topics contained in the Guidelines and to be discussed at the meeting include:

- Chapter 2 – Process and Evaluation
- Chapter 3 – Base WMP Technical Requirements
- Chapter 4 – Petition to Amend

- Appendix C – Additional Maps
- Appendix D – Areas for Continued Improvement
