

SAFETY CERTIFICATION GUIDELINES INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

- ☐ An electrical corporation seeking a Safety Certification must:
 - Satisfy requirements pursuant to Public Utilities Code section 8389(e).
- ☐ The Safety Certification Guidelines:
 - Set forth requirements for an electrical corporation to prepare and submit a request for a Safety Certification, and
 - Prescribe the specific information an electrical corporation must provide in its filing.
- ☐ Additional process requirements are outlined in the Energy Safety Policy Division (ESPD) Process Guidelines.



SAFETY CERTIFICATION GUIDELINES REVISIONS

☐ The following revisions were made to the Safety Certification Guidelines from 2024 to 2025:

 Added version control to the Guidelines to identify, organize and manage current and previous versions of the Guidelines;


 Removed duplicative information provided in the newly adopted Energy Safety Policy Division Process Guidelines;

 Added a requirement to include any catch-back plans for Wildfire Mitigation Plans (WMPs), if available, in the quarterly progress report on WMP implementation.


