Throughout	-----	HWT must correct all typos in its Base 2026-2028 Base WMP. For example: a. a. In Section 6, its narrative contains typographical errors, such as “2023=6-2028.”	HWT made the required correction on pg. 42 of its WMP.
Section 12	196	HWT stated it will transition from its asset management program (AMP) to Elements, an upgraded version of its in-house asset management program, ¹ but HWT did not include transition timelines or milestones in its WMP. In response to Data Request HWT DR-004 Q02, HWT provided its transition timelines with details. ² HWT must update its WMP to incorporate the transition timelines and milestones, as provided in its HWT DR-004 Q02 response.	HWT updated page 195 and 197 of its WMP to incorporate the transition timelines and milestones, as provided in its response to DR-004 Q02. This update includes adding the transition as Initiative in Table 12-1.
