SCE Response

Finding:

Summary of Findings:

Energy Safety’s Notice states that in implementing 2025 WMP initiative 8.1.3.1 - Distribution High Fire Risk-Informed (HFRI) Inspections and Remediations (IN-1.1), SCE failed to complete the remediation of a primary bushing avian protection on Pole ID 1569560E, Grid Hardening ID 414768411-1569560E at coordinates 34.2616914415583, -117.207866243973.

Energy Safety states that it “considers this non-performance to be in the Minor risk category.”¹

Response:

SCE confirms the remediation to remove acorns from the avian protection on structure 1569560E was completed on September 17, 2025. Please find photo evidence below of the remediation from September 17, 2025.

During a subsequent inspection in response to this Notice, SCE’s Field Operations team identified that the avian protection had again become filled with acorns due to animal activity. SCE created Notification #415198776 to remove the acorns from the avian protection. The estimated completion date is September 10, 2026, which is within the 12-month correction timeline specified in the Notice.
