Ticket Tip of the Month

Next Job Phase

Working over a large area? The **Next Job Phase** feature makes it easy to divide your project into smaller sections that comply with our ticket size policy. Most 811 tickets are limited to a maximum of one-half mile area per ticket, so larger projects must be broken into multiple tickets.

After submitting your first ticket, select **Next Job Phase** from the **Secondary Actions** menu to copy the existing information onto a new ticket. You can then highlight the next segment on the map, using the included reference map as a guide, and provide an updated description that matches the work area mapping on the current ticket.
