Re: Postponing Schedule for PG&E's Safety Certification Request Submission

On July 26, 2021, the Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety (Energy Safety) issued guidance to electrical corporations seeking a Safety Certification.¹ In the guidance letter, Energy Safety established submission dates and timelines for 2021 Safety Certification requests. Energy Safety reserved: "if any of these dates need to be changed due to unforeseen circumstances, [it] will notify the impacted electrical corporations." Energy Safety is hereby notifying Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) that PG&E's September 13, 2021, submission deadline is postponed.

Each electrical corporation seeking a Safety Certification must brief the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and Energy Safety on safety performance to demonstrate that it meets the requirements set forth in Public Utilities Code section 8389(e)(5).³ PG&E's briefing has not yet been scheduled,⁴ necessitating the postponement of PG&E's Safety Certification request submission.

A new submission date and corresponding timeline for PG&E's 2021 Safety Certification will be confirmed in due course. The new submission date will be within one year of January 14, 2021, the approval date of PG&E's current Safety Certification.
