

# Summary of Key Changes in City of Rancho Cucamonga's 2021 Wildfire Mitigation Plan

September 16, 2021

This document provides a summary of the key changes between the City of Rancho Cucamonga Municipal Utility's (RCMU's) current Wildfire Mitigation Plan (WMP) (dated June 2, 2021), and RCMU's prior Wildfire Mitigation Plan (dated December 18, 2019). As part of its 2021 submission to the Wildfire Safety Advisory Board (WSAB), RCMU provided an Informational Response document, which responded to each of the recommendations made by the WSAB in the *Guidance Advisory Opinion for the 2021 Wildfire Mitigation Plans of Electric Publicly Owned Utilities and Cooperatives*.

This document is intended to simplify the process of reviewing RCMU's current WMP, but does not represent a comprehensive identification of every single update to RCMU's WMP. Further, this summary is not part of or a supplement to RCMU's WMP. Therefore, a full review of RCMU's wildfire mitigation efforts should be based on the actual WMP and Informational Response documents.

## 1. WMP Metrics and Performance

As described in section VII of RCMU's WMP, RCMU measures the performance of its WMP by tracking the following metrics: (1) fire ignitions; and (2) wires down events. RCMU made no changes to the metrics for its current WMP, but updated the table which provides the data for these metrics through the end of calendar year 2020:
