

Summary of Key Changes in Industry Public Utilities’ 2021 Wildfire Mitigation Plan

September 20, 2021

This document provides a summary of the key changes between Industry Public Utilities’ (IPU) current Wildfire Mitigation Plan (WMP) (dated July 8, 2021), and IPU’s prior WMP (dated December 12, 2019). As part of its 2021 submission to the Wildfire Safety Advisory Board (WSAB), IPU provided an Informational Response document, which responded to each of the recommendations made by the WSAB in the *Guidance Advisory Opinion for the 2021 Wildfire Mitigation Plans of Electric Publicly Owned Utilities and Cooperatives*.

This document is intended to simplify the process of reviewing IPU’s current WMP, but does not represent a comprehensive identification of every single update to IPU’s WMP. Further, this summary is not part of or a supplement to IPU’s WMP. Therefore, a full review IPU’s wildfire mitigation efforts should be based on the actual WMP and Informational Response documents.

IPU’s July 8, 2021 WMP made no major changes from IPU’s prior WMP. The following sections provide relevant information on key areas of interest.

1. WMP Metrics and Performance

As described in Section VII of the IPU WMP, IPU measures the performance of its WMP by tracking the following metrics: (1) fire ignitions; and (2) wires down events. IPU made no changes to the metrics for its current WMP. The following table provides the data for these metrics through the end of calendar year 2020:
