

Summary of Key Changes in CEU's 2021 Wildfire Mitigation Plan

September 28, 2021

This document provides a summary of the key changes between Cerritos Electric Utility's (CEU) current Wildfire Mitigation Plan (WMP) (dated May 27, 2021), and CEU's prior Wildfire Mitigation Plan (dated November 25, 2019 and Updated June 8, 2020). As part of its 2021 submission to the Wildfire Safety Advisory Board (WSAB), CEU provided an Informational Response document, which responded to each of the recommendations made by the WSAB in the *Guidance Advisory Opinion for the 2021 Wildfire Mitigation Plans of Electric Publicly Owned Utilities and Cooperatives*.

This document is intended to simplify the process of reviewing CEU's current WMP, but does not represent a comprehensive identification of every single update to CEU's WMP. Further, this summary is not part of or a supplement to CEU's WMP. Therefore, a full review CEU's wildfire mitigation efforts should be based on the actual WMP and Informational Response documents.

1. WMP Metrics and Performance

As stated in its 2019 WMP and 2020 Update, CEU does not own any electrical system infrastructure and therefore, cannot use a wires down or ignition based metric to evaluate its WMP. CEU will evaluate alternative options to measure plan performance in the future.

2. Public Safety Power Shutoffs (PSPS)

As stated in CEU's 2019 WMP and 2020 Update, PSPS events are covered under Southern California Edison's (SCE's) PSPS program.

The 2021 WMP was updated to include more detail as to how CEU coordinates with SCE and communicates with its customers in the event SCE calls a PSPS. SCE will alert the City of Cerritos by contacting specific employees via email and phone. CEU then notifies customers of the PSPS using the City's emergency notification system as well as regular communication methods. Impact to public safety is minimal. (CEU 2021 WMP Section V. B.)

3. Other Changes

There were no other substantive changes to CEU's 2021 WMP.
