

Summary of Key Changes in BWP's 2021 Wildfire Mitigation Plan

September 27, 2021

This document provides a summary of the key changes between BWP's 2021 Wildfire Mitigation Plan (WMP), and BWP's 2020 Wildfire Mitigation Plan. As part of its 2021 submission to the Wildfire Safety Advisory Board (WSAB), BWP provided an Informational Response document, which responded to each of the recommendations made by the WSAB in the *Guidance Advisory Opinion for the 2021 Wildfire Mitigation Plans of Electric Publicly Owned Utilities and Cooperatives*, issued on December 15, 2020.

This document is intended to simplify the process of reviewing BWP's current WMP but does not represent a comprehensive identification of every update to BWP's WMP. Further, this summary is not part of or a supplement to BWP's WMP. Therefore, a full review of BWP's wildfire mitigation efforts should be based on the actual WMP and Informational Response documents.
