Summary of Key Changes in City of Shasta Lake's 2021 Wildfire Mitigation Plan

September 30, 2021

This document provides a summary of the key changes between City of Shasta Lake's (COSL) current Wildfire Mitigation Plan (WMP) (dated March 1, 2021), and COSL's prior Wildfire Mitigation Plan (dated January 1, 2020). As part of its 2021 submission to the Wildfire Safety Advisory Board (WSAB), COSL provided an Informational Response document, which responded to each of the recommendations made by the WSAB in the *Guidance Advisory Opinion for the 2021 Wildfire Mitigation Plans of Electric Publicly Owned Utilities and Cooperatives*, issued on December 15, 2020.

This document is intended to simplify the process of reviewing COSL's current WMP, but does not represent a comprehensive identification of every single update to COSL's WMP. Further, this summary is not part of or a supplement to COSL's WMP. Therefore, a full review COSL's wildfire mitigation efforts should be based on the actual WMP and Informational Response documents.

<u>Section IV: Wildfire Risks and Drivers Associated with Design, Construction, Operation, and Maintenance</u>

Changes were made throughout Section IV (at 8-11) to expand upon the basic cause-effect relationships between potential wildfire ignition sources that result from foreign objects contacting electrified assets.

Section V: Wildfire Preventative Strategies

Changes were made to Part B (at 13-14) to incorporate the electric department procedure used on days designated as an "extreme" operating condition.
