This document provides a summary of the key changes between the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power's (LADWP's) current Wildfire Mitigation Plan (WMP) (dated 4/21/2021), and LADWP's prior Wildfire Mitigation Plan (dated 4/17/2020). As part of its 2021 submission to the Wildfire Safety Advisory Board (WSAB), LADWP provided an Informational Response document, which responded to each of the recommendations made by the WSAB in the Guidance Advisory Opinion for the 2021 Wildfire Mitigation Plans of Electric Publicly Owned Utilities and Cooperatives.

This document is intended to simplify the process of reviewing LADWP's current WMP, but does not represent a comprehensive identification of every single update to LADWP's WMP. Further, this summary is not part of or a supplement to LADWP's WMP. Therefore, a full review LADWP's wildfire mitigation efforts should be based on the actual WMP and Informational Response documents. The table below provides a high-level summary of the key updates.

6	Community Outreach and Public Awareness	Provided more information on LADWP's Community Outreach and Public Awareness as it relates to: updates to the public and outreach to external agencies and neighboring utilities.
