SDG&E appreciates the opportunity to participate in the Risk Spend Efficiency (RSE) workshop that was held by Energy Safety on December 9, 2021. SDG&E looks forward to the opportunity to participate in ongoing discussion facilitated by Energy Safety around RSEs. Given that the evolution of RSEs can have significant impacts across organizations and programs, SDG&E suggests allowing a commensurate amount of time to allow for new ideas to develop around best practices and taking a paced approach with any potential changes.
