Good Morning Stephanie,

There are a number of state agencies that currently have contracts in place for document accessibility services that can be found on <u>CMAS</u>. One of the primary vendors that I found that a few state agencies contract with is <u>Access Ingenuity</u>. Their pricing structure is as follows:

- For a contract with less than 10,000 total pages per year:
 - For simple documents (i.e., standard Word documents) = \$4 per page
 - For medium documents (i.e., with column text) = \$5 per page
 - For complex documents (i.e., with complex tables) = \$6 per page
 - For fillable documents = separate quote
- If we got a contract for more than 10,000 pages total per year, then price per page drops according to higher tiers of volume.
