WORKSHOP ON DRAFT 2023-2025 WILDFIRE MITIGATION PLAN GUIDELINES

The Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety (Energy Safety) recently published draft 2023-2025 Wildfire Mitigation Plan (WMP) Guidelines and related documents. Energy Safety will host a public workshop on October 17, 2022, to take public comments on the documents below:

- Draft 2023-2025 Technical Guidelines, including Maturity Model (published September 19, 2022)¹
- Draft 2023-2025 Process and Evaluation Guidelines (published September 19, 2022)²
- Draft 2023-2025 Maturity Survey (Published September 21, 2022)³
- Draft 2023-2025 Independent Transmission Operator Supplement (to be published)
- Draft 2023 WMP Submission Schedule (to be published)

Energy Safety invites members of the public, stakeholders, and local and regional agencies, boards, tribes, and commissions to participate in the workshop.

Public Questions and Comments




