Southern California Edison Company (SCE) submitted a request for written hearing on August 22, 2022 for the following two findings in Notice of Violation - SCE ATJ 20220411-01: finding #1 related to anti-rotational clip issue, and finding #2 related to vibration damper six inch issue.

On October 24, 2022, the Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety (Energy Safety) removed these two findings and submitted a revised Notice of Violation. Accordingly, SCE requests to withdraw its written hearing request related to the two specific findings noted above. SCE appreciates Energy Safety's effort to identify, communicate, and work together to resolve potential wildfire risks.
