Re: Expectations for Projections in Quarterly Data Report Table 10: Recent use of Public Safety Power Shutoffs (PSPS) and other PSPS metrics

On December 14, 2022, the Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety (Energy Safety) adopted the Energy Safety Data Guidelines at a public meeting. As part of the Data Guidelines, Energy Safety provided an Excel template for the Quarterly Data Report (QDR) Wildfire Mitigation Data Tables 1-15 (the “Template”).¹

In the Template, Table 10: Recent use of PSPS and other PSPS metrics, columns W – AH, Energy Safety asks electrical corporations for “Projected” PSPS metrics for 2023, 2024, and 2025, respectively. In the electrical corporation Q4 2022 QDR submissions, due February 1, 2023, Energy Safety expects each electrical corporation to provide projections in columns W - AH for only the following PSPS metrics:

- 1.a Frequency of PSPS events
- 1.b Scope of PSPS events
- 1.c Duration of PSPS events
- 4.a # of customers impacted by PSPS

Energy Safety will amend the Data Guidelines to reflect these expectations.
