This matter was submitted to Julie Cabos-Owen, Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) at the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH), on March 10, 2023. ALJ Cabos-Owen considered information submitted by the Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety (“Energy Safety”) and the Southern California Edison Company (“Edison”), and on April 3, 2023, issued her proposed decision upholding the 22 Notices of Violation (“NOV”) and dismissing the Notice of Defect (“NOD”) issued to Edison.

On April 19, 2023, Energy Safety made the proposed decision available for public review and comment, posting the decision on its website and its e-filing system under the Electrical: Compliance Enforcement > 2021-NOV docket. During the time period for public comment, which ended May 4, 2023, only Edison submitted comments.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 29104(g), the Director of Energy Safety reviewed the proposed decision and the following documents:

1. Energy Safety’s Memorandum of Points and Authorities;
2. Energy Safety’s exhibits;
3. Edison’s Memorandum of Law;
4. Edison’s exhibits and the Declarations of Niousha Tavakoli and Arianne Luy; and
5. Edison’s comments submitted during the public comment period.

The Director of Energy Safety finds the proposed decision to be well reasoned and hereby concurs with those findings and adopts the proposed decision as the final decision of Energy Safety. Regarding the failures to install vibration dampers, those 22 NOV’s are upheld. Regarding the “bird caging” of a line, that NOD is dismissed.
