#### **Executive Summary:**

Phoenix Electric Company was excavating to install a duct bank for the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency by trenching with an excavator when they struck an unmarked facility on October 22, 2022. After receiving locate requests following Phoenix Electric's first contact with the regional notification center (on October 11, 2022, ticket number X228404711-00X), four operators on the ticket did not provide an electronic positive response, and one operator provided an electronic positive response the day after the "legal start" date indicated on the ticket. All four operators are members of the regional notification center.

Three days after damaging the unmarked line, Phoenix Electric contacted the regional notification center, which generated ticket number X228404711-01X (damage ticket). No operator claimed ownership of the unmarked line following the creation of that damage ticket.

During the investigation, the investigator asked the nine operators on the ticket about ownership of the unmarked, damaged line. Five operators responded to those requests and denied ownership. Four operators, all part of the City and County of San Francisco, did not respond to the investigator's request.

The investigation was not able to determine the owner of the unmarked facility that Phoenix Electric encountered.

In February 2023, the Board mailed Notices of Probable Violation (NOPV) to all the subjects of this investigation and received the mail postmarked return to sender for all NOPV's.

### **Scene Description:**

Multilane intersection in an urban area near a crosswalk with trenching excavation running through the middle of 16<sup>th</sup> Street.

#### <u>Investigation:</u>

Phoenix Electric submitted damage ticket X228404711-01X (Exh. 1.), at 2:39 pm on October 25, 2022, about a possible telecommunications facility that it had damaged on October 22, 2022, at the intersection of 16<sup>th</sup> Street and Potrero Avenue in San Francisco. (Exh. 2.) Phoenix Electric submitted damage notification D22298003 through the damage reporting portal, which was received by the Board's investigation case management system at 2:51 pm on October 25, 2022.

### <u>Damage to Unidentified</u> Facility

I interviewed Arjun Subburam of Phoenix Electric Company by phone on October 27, 2022, and again, via email, on November 9, 2022, (Exh. 2 and 3.) After the phone interview, I immediately

On October 31, 2022, I emailed Subburam regarding whether the dig ticket number was correct and whether any operator had claimed the damaged utility. Subburam did not respond (Exh. 2.)

On November 2, 2022, I again requested information from Subburam by email. Subburam that same day (Exh. 2.)

On November 9, 2022, as I still had not received the photographs or additional requested information from Subburam, I emailed him. Subburam replied by email on November 9, 2022, and indicated the following:

- Phoenix Electric Company was excavating with a Cat 305 excavator and struck an unmarked facility at a depth of about 30 inches.
- The facility was a 4-inch conduit, possibly made of asbestos that was damaged.
- The conduit contained an interior cable that was undamaged in the incident.
- The cable inside the conduit was possibly a telecommunications cable.
- The facility was not either a water or sewer facility, and they believed the interior cable to be electrified.
- Subburam believed the facility was a telecommunication Comcast facility.
   Some utility operators had visited the site in response to the damaged ticket X228404711-01X.
- Pacific Gas & Electric visited the site and stated it was not their facility.
- No operator had claimed ownership of the facility as of November 9, 2022. (Exh. 2 and 3.)

Phoenix Electric Company provided the following photos of the unmarked facility to aid in the investigation.

## **Electronic Positive Responses**

The initial ticket X228404711-00X was created on October 11, 2022, with a legal start time of October 13, 2022, at 5:01 pm. (Exh. 4.)

The City and County of San Francisco Heat/Power/Light Department provided its electronic positive response late, on October 14, 2022, at 6:24 am, with the code "(001) Clear – No Conflict". (Exh. 5.)

Four operators did not provide an electronic positive response to the ticket according to a search of the USA North 811 Ticket Report database by the investigator (member responses below), each listed with their USA North 811 Member Code as it appears on the ticket:

- 1. CTYSF2 City and County of San Francisco Water
- 2. CTYSFO City and County of San Francisco Parking and Traffic
- 3. MUNUTL Municipal Overhead Lines Department
- 4. SFOTEC City and County of San Francisco Department of Technology

The remaining operators provided an electronic positive response code before the legal start.

# <u>Letters to Operators Regarding the Unidentified Facility</u>

I emailed USA North 811 for contact information for all members associated with Ticket X228404711 and received a spreadsheet of that information on November 22, 2022 (Exh. 14 and 15).

Using the photographs provided by the excavator, on November 28, 2022, I sent letters to each of the operators listed on the ticket requesting ownership of the facility and how the operator came to that determination.

Four operators responded to the first request:

On December 13, 2022, Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E) responded via email to my request and stated:

- PG&E does not own the facility.
- The "excavator verified it was a communication line," and
- A PG&E response was not required. (Exh. 8.)

On December 1, 2022, Comcast responded via email to my request and stated:

- Comcast does not own the facility.
- Comcast facilities were located across the intersection of the incident site and markings were still present on site.
- That the closest vault to the construction was PacBell/AT&T. (Exh. 6, 7.)




Photo 6: Map and information provided by Comcast. (Exh. 7.)

On November 29, 2022, the City and County of San Francisco Department of Technology responded via email to my request and stated:

- City and County of San Francisco Department of Technology do not own this facility.
- They have facilities on the eastern side of Potrero on the side of the intersection that is across from where the line was damaged.
- That the Department of Technology facilities consist of four 2-inch conduits. (Exh. 9.)

On December 7, 2022, the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Overhead Lines Department responded via email to my request and stated:

- The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency engineer, in charge of the project, stated they did not own the facility.
- The contractor had identified the facility as a telecommunications facility. (Exh. 10.)

On December 27, 2022, AT&T responded via email to my second request from December 14, 2022, and stated:

- Did not own the facility.
- AT&T owns a multi-conduit structure in the area that was marked on October 12, 2022, running east to west.
- AT&T visited the site on October 26, 2022, in response to the damaged ticket and determined the facility was not theirs. (Exh. 11.)

Four operators did not respond to my email information requests, the first request was on November 28, 2022, and the second was on December 14, 2022. (Exh. 12, 13.) Contact information obtained from the ticket database maintained by the regional notification center, USA North, indicates that those four operators have the same address and point of contact. Especially, as to these four operators I sent the first letter on November 28, 2022, (Exh. 12) and the second letter on December 14, 2022. (Exh. 13.) Given the single point of contact, I directed the letter to all four operators. None of the operators ever responded. For clarity, these operators are:

- 1. CTYSF2 City and County of San Francisco Water
- 2. CTYSFO City and County of San Francisco Parking and Traffic
- 3. CTYSF3 City and County of San Francisco Public Works
- 4. CTYSF4 City and County of San Francisco Heat/Power/Light

### <u>Mailing Notices of Probable Violation</u>

In February 2023, the Board mailed Notices of Probable Violation (NOPV) to all the subjects of this investigation:

- 1. City and County of San Francisco Water Department
- 2. City and County of San Francisco Public Works Department
- 3. City and County of San Francisco Heat/Power/Light Department
- 4. City and County of San Francisco Parking & Traffic Department
- 5. City and County of San Francisco Department of Technology
- 6. San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Overhead Lines Department
- 7. Phoenix Electric Company

On February 15, 2023, the Board received 6 NOPV's postmarked as return to sender for the following subjects of the investigation:

- 1. City and County of San Francisco Water Department
- 2. City and County of San Francisco Public Works Department
- 3. City and County of San Francisco Heat/Power/Light Department
- 4. City and County of San Francisco Parking & Traffic Department
- 5. City and County of San Francisco Department of Technology
- 6. San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Overhead Lines Department

The Board mailed NOPV's to four operator members at the address on file at the regional notification center provided by USA North 811 on November 22, 2022 (Exh. 15.):

- 1. CTYSF2 City and County of San Francisco Water
- 2. CTYSFO City and County of San Francisco Parking and Traffic
- 3. CTYSF3 City and County of San Francisco Public Works
- 4. CTYSF4 City and County of San Francisco Heat/Power/Light

On February 16, 2023, the investigator emailed USA North 811 for updated contact information for the operator members on Ticket X228404711 and received updated contact information on March 6, 2023. (Exh. 16 and 17.)

In March 2023, the Board received the NOPV mailed to Phoenix Electric Company as return to sender.

#### Findings:

1. City and County of San Francisco Heating/Power/Light Department (USA North Member Code CTYSF4) provided its electronic positive response after the legal start time.

Government Code §4216.3 (c)(1)(a) requires operators to respond with an electronic positive response prior to the legal start of the ticket. USA North Ticket Report records show that CTYSF4 provided a late electronic positive response to ticket X228404711-00X. The legal start for this ticket was October 13, 2022, at 5:01 pm and the response from CTYSF4 is recorded as 6:24 am on October 14, 2022.

2. Four operators did not provide an electronic positive response: (1) City and County of San Francisco Department of Technology (USA North Member Code SFOTEC), (2) City and County of San Francisco Water (USA North Member Code CTYSF2), (3) City and County of San Francisco Parking & Traffic (USA North Member Code CTYSF0), and (4) San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Overhead Lines Department (USA North Member Code MUNUTL).

Government Code §4216.3 (c)(1)(a) requires operators to respond with an electronic positive response prior to the legal start of the ticket. USA North Ticket Report records show that USA North 811 ticket system assigned these operator members electronic positive response "Code 999 – Utility has not provided 811 center with information to be displayed" and did not provide a response as of its search on December 19, 2022.

3. None of the operators who responded to the investigator's request for information claimed ownership of the damaged facility.

Operators PG&E, AT&T, Comcast, City and County of San Francisco Department of Technology, and San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency Overhead Lines Department denied owning the unmarked, damaged facility.

4. Four operators that are part of the City and County of San Francisco failed to respond to the investigator's requests for information: (1) City and County of San Francisco Water (USA North Member Code CTYSF2), (2) City and County of San Francisco Parking and Traffic (USA North Member Code CTYSF0), (3) City and County of San Francisco Public Works (USA North Member Code CTYSF3), and (4) City and County of San Francisco Heat/Power/Light (USA North Member Code CTYSF4) departments.

CCR 19 § 4151(c) states that excavators or operators that take actions reasonably known to hinder or impede an investigation are subject to sanctions.

The City and County of San Francisco Water (CTYSF2), Parking and Traffic (CTYSF0), Public Works (CTYSF3), and Heat/Power/Light (CTYSF4) departments did not respond to the first and second requests to determine whether they owned the facility in question and how they arrived at that determination.

5. Phoenix Electric reported the damage to the regional notification center after the closure of the 48-hour requirement.

Government Code §4216.4 (c)(3) requires excavators to report the discovery or occurrence of any facility damage to the regional notification center within 48 hours.

Phoenix Electric stated that the damage to this facility occurred on October 22, 2022 and submitted damage ticket X228404711-01X to USA North 811 on October 25, 2022, outside of the 48-hour requirement.

6. Four operators failed to maintain current contact information with the regional notification center: (1) City and County of San Francisco Water (USA North Member Code CTYSF2), (2) City and County of San Francisco Parking and Traffic (USA North Member Code CTYSF0), (3) City and County of San Francisco Public Works (USA North Member Code CTYSF3), and (4) City and County of San Francisco Heat/Power/Light (USA North Member Code CTYSF4) departments.

CCR 19 § 4003 (a) states that members of regional notification centers must maintain current contact information and update the regional notification center with any changes of their contact information.

The Board mailed Notices of Probable Violation (NOPV) to four operator members at the address provided by the regional notification center and the mail was returned to the Board postmarked as return to sender.

The City and County of San Francisco Water (CTYSF2), Parking and Traffic (CTYSF0), Public Works (CTYSF3), and Heat/Power/Light (CTYSF4) departments did not maintain current contact information with the regional notification center.

### Hi Mcclenahan,

- 1. Yes the USA ticket for this job is X228404711
- 2. We believe it's a comcast line.
- 3. CAT 305E excavator was used during the time of damage.
- 4. The Comcast line was unmarked, while we were carefully excavating our trench we hit the unmarked comcast line. This was a 4" pipe(maybe asbestos) found at a depth of 30". The cable inside was still not damaged. We cleaned the damaged part of the pipe, installed spliced PVC pipe over the undamaged cable after calling USA as no one claimed for it.
- 5. This damage happened on 10/22/22. I have attached our USA ticket that was live in this location during this time.






