


Important Updates to Our Online Ticket Entry System



We're excited to share that we've made some important updates to our online ticket entry system to enhance your user experience and ensure safety during all your excavation projects. Watch our update video for more detailed explanations and examples of these changes.

Key Changes include:

- 1. Reverse Geocode Pop Up: When a different address is associated with your highlighted area than what was used for your initial search, our system will provide a pop-up to alert you. You will have the option to keep the initial street or address, replace it with the system suggested information, or change it to something else.
- Open Positive Response Tool: You can look up the positive response codes on your 811 tickets right from our website, no login required. This feature is especially useful for field personnel who might not have an account with



Ticket System Updates

- Google Maps update system will prompt user if polygon drawn on map overlaps an address that is different than what was entered by the user.
- Positive Response lookup, no login needed (primarily for use in the field)




New vs. Renewal Tickets 2022-2023 -- California

Data Mining: Ticket Volume 2023

While ticket volume in northern California is down 167K vs. 2022 (YTD through 5/31), this is primarily due to fewer Renewal tickets (down 137K).


We believe this is due to existing tickets not being able to be imported from the old ticket system (Newtin) into the new ticket system (One Call Access), which caused excavators to review their tickets carefully, and not spend the effort to manually create unneeded tickets in the new system.


