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HWT notes the following to provide context to its responses:
HWT's Suncrest Facility consists of the Suncrest Static Var Compensator (SVC) and its 230 kV single-circuit transmission line installed underground.

REQUEST

Q01. Environmental Compliance and Permitting

Horizon West Transmission (HWT) Response:

As a general matter, the corporate environmental services department supports HWT by assessing the environmental risks, applicable regulations and requirements of improvements projects. The department works with consultants, experts and environmental agencies to determine applicable regulations, requirements and support permit procurement as needed. As noted in HWT's WMP, HWT identified fire risk reduction improvements that were contained within the footprint of its Suncrest Substation and easement on neighboring SDG&E substation property, none of which required new environmental permits.
