SUBJECT: Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety Issuance of Statement of Substantive Erratum for LS Power's 2023-2025 Wildfire Mitigation Plan

Dear Mr. Hohlt:

In accordance with the Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety's (Energy Safety's) 2023-2025 Wildfire Mitigation Plan Process and Evaluation Guidelines,¹ Energy Safety requests that LS Power address substantive errata that Energy Safety found in reviewing its 2023-2025 Wildfire Mitigation Plan (Base Plan or WMP).

LS Power must revise its WMP to address the following errata:

- Correct section 9.1.2 to include an affirmative statement that LS Power does not have any frequently de-energized circuits.
- Correct section 9.2 to include LS Power's plan for developing PSPS protocols.

LS Power must include a revised WMP to the 2023-2025 Wildfire Mitigation Plans docket (#2023-2025-WMPs) and notify via email the Deputy Director of the Electrical Infrastructure Directorate of the submission by October 18, 2023.²
