In accordance with California Public Utilities Code Section 8386.3(c)(5)(A), Southern California Edison Company is providing notification to the Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety that it has completed a substantial portion of two of its 2023 Wildfire Mitigation Plan vegetation management initiatives as of September 30, 2023, as shown in the table below.

VM-1: Hazard Tree	
SCE plans to inspect 412 grids/circuits and prescribe mitigation for hazardous trees with strike potential within those grids in SCE's HFRA.	350
VM-4: Dead and Dying Tree Removal	
SCE plans to inspect 509 grids/circuits and prescribe mitigation for dead and dying trees with strike potential within those grids/circuits.	434
