Submission of an idea does not assure Board action; all ideas are weighed against the Board's strategic directives and planned objectives and activities which are generally considered on a yearly basis. While you are not required to fill the form out in its entirety, missing information may not provide the Board with the details it needs to fully understand the issue.

Use of this form is not required to provide comment to the Board. Members of the public may provide comment to the Board at public meetings or in writing at any time.

You may provide your completed form to the Board in the following ways:
