## SUBJECT: Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety Non-Substantive Errata Request for Southern California Edison Company's 2024 Executive Compensation Structure

- Remove the redlines on the Titles and Headers of Table 1.6.1 and Table 1.6.2.
- Clearly mark any redacted information in the public version of the document.

SCE must revise and submit its Executive Compensation Structure Submission to the 2024-Executive Compensation docket (#2024-EC) and notify via email the Program Manager of the Electrical Safety Policy Division of the submission by April 26, 2024.<sup>2</sup>
