Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) is providing notice to the Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety (Energy Safety), pursuant to California Public Utilities Code Section 8386.3(c)(5)(a), that seven of our eighteen 2024 Wildfire Mitigation Plan vegetation management initiatives have been substantially completed. We interpret substantial completion to mean completion of 80% or more of our annual target for each initiative.
