In accordance with California Public Utilities Code Section 8386.3(c)(5)(A), Southern California Edison Company is providing notification to the Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety that it has completed a substantial portion of three of its 2024 Wildfire Mitigation Plan vegetation management initiatives as of August 31, 2024, as shown in the table below.

VM-1: Hazard Tree Management Program Inspect 408 grids/circuits and prescribe mitigation for hazardous trees with strike potential within those grids in SCE's HFRA.	334
<u>VM-2: Structure Brushing</u> Inspect and clear (where clearance is needed) 63,700 structures with the exception of structures for which there are customer access or environmental constraints.	64,642
VM-8: Detailed Inspections for the Prescription, Where Necessary and Feasible of Expanded Vegetation Clearances from Transmission Lines in HFRA SCE plans to inspect 416 grids within our transmission system	361
