The Utility Reform Network (TURN) requests Data Request Stakeholder Designation for the 2025 to 2028 Wildfire Mitigation Plan (WMP) docket (#2026-2028-WMPs), for data requests to all electrical corporations within the jurisdiction of the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC).¹

TURN is a non-profit consumer advocacy organization with a long history of representing the interests of residential and small commercial customers of California's utility companies before the CPUC and, more recently, the Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety (Energy Safety). TURN has filed comments on various utility WMPs in recent years, including most recently on PG&E's 2024 Update. In its advocacy before Energy Safety and the CPUC, TURN seeks to ensure that utility wildfire mitigations are targeted to where they are most needed and consistent with a cost-effective use of ratepayer funds. Data requests are an important means by which TURN analyzes WMP submissions and supports its comments.
