PROPOSED FINAL VERSION CHANGES

- Sections 3.6.3.3.2-3.6.3.3.4,
Initiative Audit feature classes (line, point, and polygon):

	This field is required.
PerformedByComment	Entity that performed grid hardening <u>audit</u> and is not listed in options above. This field is required IF PerformedBy is "Other, see comment".

- Removal of extra spaces and insertion where spaces were missing throughout.

PROPOSED FINAL VERSION CHANGES

Geodatabase Template v4.0:

- The new Date-Only field types are now reverted to the previous Date field type
- WMPInitiativeCategory field is corrected to be WMPCategory, reflecting the field name as proposed in the Revised Draft Data Guidelines v4.0 and as described in the concurrently published GIS Change Log.
