The Mussey Grade Road Alliance (MGRA or Alliance) respectfully requests Data Request Stakeholder Designation for the 2026 to 2028 Wildfire Mitigation Plan docket (#2026-2028-WMPs) allowing to issue data requests to all electrical corporations for which Wildfire Mitigation Plans are required. MGRA has been actively participating in the review of Wildfire Mitigation Plans of PG&E, SCE, and SDG&E since their inception in 2019, and in fact even earlier, as the original proponents of requiring utilities to file catastrophic wildfire plans with the CPUC. The Mussey Grade Road area is typical of wildland urban interface areas in California, and it has been overrun by the Cedar Fire in 2003 and surrounded by the Witch and Guejito fires in 2007. MGRA has been active since 2007 trying to reduce utility wildfire risk in California, and we plan to continue our advocacy through the 2023 to 2025 WMP cycle.

It is our understanding of the adopted WMP process documents that our previous stakeholder designation is still active. Nevertheless, we file this request out of an abundance of caution.
