

Energy Safety to Hold Virtual Public Meeting for Adoption of Executive Compensation Structure Guidelines

Sacramento - The Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety (Energy Safety) will hold a virtual public meeting on April 2, at 1 p.m. for the adoption of the Executive Compensation Structure Guidelines (Guidelines) Version 1.0. **This meeting will be remote via Teams only**. Energy Safety will take public comment, present an overview of any significant changes from 2024 Executive Compensation Structure Submission Guidelines and Attachments, and consider adoption of the new Guidelines.

Energy Safety does not set or approve the actual salaries for electrical corporation executives. Electrical corporations are statutorily required (Pub. Util. Code § 8389(e)(4))(Pub. Util. Code § 8389(e)(6)) to have an executive compensation structure that meets specific criteria to be eligible for the safety certification process. The statutory criteria are intended to promote and incentivize public safety as a priority and to ensure the utility's financial stability.
