On page 7 of its 2026-2028 Base WMP Substantive Errata, PG&E lists 99,933 poles as the population size for its annual Quality Control of Pole Clearing activity. On page 356 of its 2026-2028 Base WMP, PG&E targets 70,000 poles annually for its Pole Clearing (VM-02) activity.

a. Explain why PG&E's audit population for quality control is 29,933 more poles than it targets for its pole clearing activity each year.

ANSWER 005

We apologize; the discrepancy is due to an inadvertent error. The correct population number of Quality Control Pole Clearing poles in HFRA and HFTD to be sampled from is 70,000 annually, not 99,933 poles.
