WITHDRAWAL OF NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Ms. Shinjini Menon:

The Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety (Energy Safety) issued a Notice of Violation (NOV), NOV_ESD_SCE_MAZ_20250325_1004, to Southern California Edison (SCE) on April 23, 2025, pursuant to Public Utilities Code section 326 and Government Code section 15475.1. SCE's response to the NOV, submitted on May 2, 2025, addressed the identified violation as follows:

Violation 1: SCE's response clarified that the debris left on site resulted from actions by the homeowner or their contractor in preparation for a fence replacement, not SCE's vegetation management program. Based on this information, Energy Safety has withdrawn this violation.

Energy Safety has determined that SCE has adequately addressed Energy Safety's concerns, and no further action is required by SCE.
