## WITHDRAWAL OF NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Mr. Jarrold Meier:

The Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety (Energy Safety) issued Notice of Violation (NOV), NOV ESD\_PGE\_GCA\_20250225\_1059 to Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E) on April 15, 2025,<sup>1</sup> pursuant to Public Utilities Code section 326 and Government Code section 15475.1. The NOV was issued based on information provided by PG&E in response to Energy Safety's data request dated March 11, 2025, which indicated that the slash material left on site resulted from PG&E vegetation management work. PG&E responded to the NOV on May 15, 2025, with additional information that clarified the debris was left on site at the request of the landowner. Based on this documentation, Energy Safety has withdrawn NOV ESD\_PGE\_GCA\_20250225\_1059.

No further action is required by PG&E.
