Reid Concrete Construction Inc.	Excavating without first notifying the Regional
Government Code § 4216.2(b):	Notification Center.
Government Code § 4216.4(c)(1):	Excavator failure to call 911 emergency services upon discovering or causing damage to subsurface installation resulting in the escape of flammable, toxic, or corrosive gas or liquid.

Executive Summary:

On September 30, 2024, at 9:50 a.m., Reid Concrete Construction Inc. excavated without first contacting the Regional Notification Center and, with a shovel, damaged an ½" plastic natural gas facility while digging a trench for a natural gas line. Upon the escape of gas from the subsurface installation, Reid Concrete Construction Inc. did not call 911 emergency services to report it. No one was injured and no equipment, other than the natural gas facility, was damaged.

Investigation:

Notification of the Incident

On October 9, 2024, at 4:14 p.m., Southern California Gas Company submitted a notification of an incident to the California Underground Safety Board. The notification stated, "Contractor was digging a trench for natural gas line to an ADU and pool, no USA and hit our service." (Exh. 1.)

The case was assigned to Investigator Angel Barton (Investigator).

Reid Concrete Construction, Inc. Damaged a Gas Line While Digging A Trench

Government Code section 4216(h) defines an excavator to be "any person, firm, contractor or subcontractor, owner, operator, utility, association, corporation, partnership, business trust, public agency, or other entity that, with their own employees or equipment, performs any excavation."

Reid Concrete Construction, Inc. was digging a trench with a shovel and damaged a ½" plastic gas line at 26572 Pariso Drive, Mission Viejo, California 92691, on September 30, 2024, at approximately 9:50 a.m. (Exh. 2.)

Reid Concrete Construction Inc. was licensed, as of November 4, 2024, by the California Contractors State License Board, license number 904326 with C-8 – Concrete, C27 – Landscaping, and C53 – Swimming Pool Classifications. (Exh. 3.)

<u>Reid Concrete Construction Inc. Did Not Contact the Regional Notification Center Before</u> <u>Excavating</u>

Government Code section 4216.2(b) states that an excavator planning to excavate shall notify the appropriate regional notification center of the excavator's intent to excavate at least two working days, and not more than 14 calendar days, before beginning that excavation.

Reid Concrete Construction Inc. did not notify the regional notification center prior to digging a trench with a shovel at 26572 Pariso Drive, Mission Viejo, California 92691, on September 30, 2024. The reason that the construction owner, John Reid, Reid Concrete Construction Inc., gave for not contacting the Regional Notification Center first was "There were marked gas lines from years ago in the dirt. We were aware of the gas lines that were underground. Although being as careful as can be we still nicked a very old gas line." (Exh. 2.)

On November 4, 2024, Investigator emailed Amber Dahl, Safety Awareness Director at DigAlert, requesting ticket information for 26572 Pariso Drive, Mission Viejo, California 92691, between August 30, 2024, and October 14, 2024. (Exh. 4.)

Safety Awareness Director, Amber Dahl responded on November 6, 2024, confirming that a ticket did not exist for 26572 Pariso Drive, Mission Viejo, California 92691, on September 30, 2024. (Exh. 5.)

Reid Concrete Construction Inc. Did Not Call 911 Emergency Services Upon Gas Release

Government Code section 4216.4(c)(1) states an excavator shall call 911 emergency services upon discovering or causing damage to a gas or hazardous liquid pipeline subsurface installation in which the damage results in the escape of any flammable, toxic, or corrosive gas or liquid.

On September 30, 2024, at approximately 9:50 a.m., Reid Concrete Construction Inc. damaged a half-inch plastic natural gas line while using a shovel but did not call 911 afterward. (Exh. 2.)

Findings:

1. Reid Concrete Construction Inc. failed to contact the Regional Notification Center before digging a trench with a shovel on September 30, 2024, at 26572 Pariso Drive, Mission Viejo, California 92691.

2. On September 30, 2024, Reid Concrete Construction Inc., excavating with a shovel to install a natural gas line, failed to call 911 emergency services to report the damage of the gas line and the escape of gas from a subsurface installation.




