# California Underground Facilities Safe Excavation Board

In the Matter of Patriot Construction Services, Respondent Case No. C232960003

### **DECISION REGARDING NOTICE OF PROBABLE VIOLATION**

On April 14, 2025, the Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety, California Underground Facilities Safe Excavation Board (the Board) considered Case No. C232960003. Board investigative staff issued a Notice of Probable Violation (NOPV) to Patriot Construction Services (Respondent), dated February 24, 2025, alleging violations of Government Code (Gov. Code) sections 4216.2(b), (g), and (e). Respondent did not submit a response to the NOPV.

Board members Charland, Clausen, Johns, Johnson, and Sorem participated in the decision. Board Member Muñoz was not present for the meeting.

#### **FINDINGS**

Having considered the investigation report, the Board finds that Respondent violated Gov. Code section §4216.2(b), (e), and (g).

### **VIOLATION SUMMARY**

On October 23, 2023, Patriot Construction Services excavated to expose the top of a buried utility vault. Patriot did not contact the regional notification center before starting the excavation.

## **JURISDICTION**

This matter is subject to the jurisdiction of the CONTRACTOR STATE LICENSE BOARD.

### **SANCTIONS**

The Board RECOMMENDS that the CONTRACTOR STATE LICENSE BOARD order Respondent to take the Board's education course and pay a penalty of \$1000.

- Respondent excavated without notifying the regional notification center.
- The violation did not result in death or substantial injury or environment or property damage.
