DECISION REGARDING NOTICE OF PROBABLE VIOLATION

On April 14, 2025, the Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety, California Underground Facilities Safe Excavation Board (the Board) considered Case No. C241990006. Board investigative staff issued a Notice of Probable Violation (NOPV) to Shaheen Pasha, (Respondent), dated February 24, 2025, alleging a violation of Government Code (Gov. Code) section 4216.2(b). Respondent submitted a written response to the NOPV.

Board members Charland, Clausen, Johns, Johnson, and Sorem participated in the decision. Board Member Muñoz was not present for the meeting.

FINDINGS

Having considered the investigation report and the Respondent's written response, the Board finds that Respondent violated Gov. Code section §4216.2(b).

VIOLATION SUMMARY

Respondent, acting as an individual and on behalf of the Pasha Real Estate Brokerage, Inc, paid two unknown people to install a billboard but failed to notify the regional notification center before digging.

JURISDICTION

This matter is subject to the jurisdiction of the California Underground Safe Excavation Board.

SANCTIONS

The Board ORDERS Respondent to take the Board's education course. In addition, within 30 days from the date of this decision letter, Respondent must provide the Board with a copy of their written procedures for billboard installation that requires excavation. This procedure must include timely notification to the regional notification center.

The following factors were considered relevant to this sanction determination:

- Respondent did not contact the regional notification center and obtain a ticket before excavation.
- The violation did not result in death or substantial injury or environment or property damage.
