# California Underground Facilities Safe Excavation Board

In the Matter of WJ Landscape Maintenance, Inc., Respondent Case No. D231510004

## **DECISION REGARDING NOTICE OF PROBABLE VIOLATION**

On April 14, 2025, the Office of Energy Infrastructure Safety, California Underground Facilities Safe Excavation Board (the Board) considered Case No. D231510004. Board investigative staff issued a Notice of Probable Violation (NOPV) to WJ Landscape Maintenance, Inc (Respondent), dated February 24, 2025, alleging violations of Government Code (Gov. Code) sections 4216.2(b), 4216.4(c)(2), and 4216.4(c)(3) and California Code of Regulations title 19, section 4100(a)(1). Respondent did not submit a timely response to the NOPV. However, Respondent attended the meeting and was allowed to make a comment to the Board before it began its deliberation.

Board members Charland, Clausen, Johns, Johnson, and Sorem participated in the decision. Board Member Muñoz was not present for the meeting.

## **FINDING**

Having considered the investigation report and the Respondent's verbal comments at the meeting, the Board finds that Respondent violated Gov. Code sections 4216.2(b) and 4216.4(c)(2) and California Code of Regulations title 19, section 4100(a)(1).

#### **VIOLATION SUMMARY**

Respondent excavated without first contacting the regional notification center and damaged a natural gas line. After damaging the line, Respondent contacted the regional notification center and the operator but did not contact 911 emergency services. After reporting the damage to the regional notification center, Respondent began excavating again before the legal excavation start date and time rather than waiting for operators to respond.

## **JURISDICTION**

This matter is subject to the jurisdiction of the CONTRACTOR STATE LICENSE BOARD.

## **SANCTIONS**

The Board RECOMMENDS that the CONTRACTOR STATE LICENSE BOARD order Respondent to take the Board's education course and pay a penalty of \$1000.

The following factors were considered relevant to this sanction determination:

- Respondent excavated without notifying the regional notification center.
- Respondent damaged a natural gas line.
- Respondent did not contact 911 emergency services to report the incident.
- The violation did not result in death or substantial injury or environment or property damage.
