Description of Revision

Revision 1 (Table 1):

Additional targets were created, and some targets were changed in our 2026-2028 WMP in response to the Revision Notice PG&E received from Energy Safety. The Annual Template, Table 1, is updated to reflect these changes.

Revision 2 (Tables 7, 8 and 9):

Overhead and Underground Distribution circuit miles have been updated in Table 7, 8 and 9 of the Annual Template to reflect the change in System Hardening targets in 2026-2028 WMP due to the Revision Notice.

Revision 3 (Table 11):

PG&E revised data in the 'Projected Cycle Year 1 Value', 'Projected Cycle Year 2 Value', and 'Projected Cycle Year 3 Value' columns in Table 11 for the 'Undergrounding of electric lines and/or equipment' and 'Mircrogrids' rows to reflect PG&E's removal of Fire Rebuild and Community Rebuild miles from its 2026-2028 WMP System Hardening Targets.¹

Revision 4 (Table 12):
