B. Statement Supporting Confidential Designation

(1) Statutory Basis for Confidentiality:

-Gov't Code §§ 6254 et seq. (now recodified at §§ 7920.000 et seq.)



OEIS has the legal right to prevent disclosure of information containing confidential business information and trade secrets.

Completed transmission substation inspection reports are LSPGC business confidential information for the reasons described below.

(2) Reason Each Exemption Applies:

a) Attachment A – As an independent transmission operator, LSPGC's CA
transmission facilities have all been the result of successful competitive
transmission proposals originating in the California ISO's planning process.
 Competitive transmission solicitations take into consideration the means,
methods, processes, and results of core operations and maintenance activities such
as substation inspections. Public disclosure of these details would be of interest to
LSPGC's competitors and could impact LSPGC's ability to compete for future
projects.

(3) Duration of Confidentiality Requested:

The processes, means, and results of LSPGC substation inspections are business
confidential and will impact LSPGC's ability to compete for additional transmission
infrastructure projects indefinitely.

C. Trade Secret or Competitive Harm Statement

LSPGC's detailed inspection records are business confidential information and the associated records are a critical part of the evaluation of competitive transmission projects. Disclosure of site-specific inspection records would give LSPGC's competitors additional insight into LSPGC's processes which could be used against LSPGC in the future. Detailed inspection results are unable to be duplicated as the data obtained during the inspection requires site access which can only be obtained credentialed personnel pursuant to NERC Critical Infrastructure Protection Standards.
