Pacific Gas and Electric Company is notifying you of the resubmission of PG&E's 2023-2025 Wildfire Mitigation Data Reports (WMDR). Pursuant to the Data Guidelines, v4.01, Section 2.4 – Revisions to Previously Submitted Data, Energy Safety instructs that, when an electrical corporation becomes aware of a need for revisions to previously submitted data, the electrical corporation provide the revisions by the next quarterly submission date.¹

Description

Revision 1:

PG&E's Q1 2025 3.6.3.3.3 Initiative Audit Point feature class.

Revision 2:

PG&E's Q1 2025 Wildfire Mitigation Data Report, Table 2, Metric Type: 14. Grid condition findings from inspection, Metric Name: Numbers of assets inspected.

Explanation for Each Revision

Revision 1:

Transmission audits reported complete by the Vegetation Management Quality Control (VM-22) and Quality Assurance (VM-08) programs were discovered to be out of scope from the approved work plan – due to not being within Tier 2 and Tier 3 HFTD areas. Based on this internal

observation, changes to the Q1 dataset were made by removing these records from the completed population.

Revision 2:

Due to an inadvertent data validation error, incorrect data was populated in the prior submission which has been corrected. Additional training was provided on how to correctly gather the data for future submissions.
