On page 37 of its 2026-2028 base WMP, HWT states, "Field engineers perform monthly substation inspections in accordance with HWT's Wildfire Mitigation Condition Assessment Procedure, which includes general checks, visual inspections, general housekeeping, vegetation control, and a review of maintenance equipment."
 - i. What activities are completed as part of "general housekeeping"?
 - ii. As part of the monthly substation inspections, do field engineers visually inspect the substations for combustible materials, trash, and/or other hazardous materials?
 - 1. If yes; is this inspection task listed on the Wildfire Mitigation Condition Assessment Procedure?
 - a) If yes, please provide the page number and location of this item.
 - b) If no, how do field engineers record and track this information?
 - 2. If no; why is this not a necessary item to track for inspections? Additionally, what do field engineers do if they discover combustible materials, trash, and/or other hazardous materials during their inspection?

HWT Response to Q01:

- i. Field engineers visually inspect areas for vegetation, wildlife, obstructions/debris, vandalism, and off normal conditions as performance of 'general housekeeping' as part of the monthly wildfire and equipment condition assessments.
- ii. Yes. The corresponding inspection items are listed in the Wildfire Mitigation Condition Assessment Procedure and accounted for in the associated inspection form(s).
