# PacifiCorp Vegetation Management Quality Management Program Guidelines

## **Program Overview**

This document describes PacifiCorp's audits and reviews of vegetation management activities for adherence with Company standards and specifications.

PacifiCorp's quality control program consists of the following:

- Quality Assurance (QA)
  - Written procedures that ensure utility vegetation management practices result in a safe and reliable network of power.
- Quality Control (QC)
  - Audit process to verify that completed vegetation maintenance meets written procedure requirements.

# **Quality Assurance**

PacifiCorp achieves quality assurance through implementation of its Transmission & Distribution Vegetation Management Program Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) and requirements therein. PacifiCorp's SOP establishes program requirements to achieve desired objectives.

# **Quality Control**

PacifiCorp conducts QC through quality reviews and post-audits to verify the effectiveness and adherence of program requirements.

#### **Quality Reviews**

Quality reviews are detailed reviews of a portion of completed work against PacifiCorp's SOP and requirements. Quality reviews are focused on random sampling of individuals or crews conducting pre-inspection, pole clearing, chemical maintenance, and tree maintenance activities, and includes review of:

- documentation review,
- vegetation maintenance performed,
- work against applicable workflows and processes,
- adherence to safety practices,
- quarterly review of contractor's credential status for continuous improvement.

Vegetation maintenance actions, frequency, and contractor personnel, that are targeted for quality reviews are presented in **Table 1**.

**Table 1. Quality Review Targets**

Pre-Inspection	Annual	Consulting Utility Foresters
Pole Clearing	Annual	Pole clearer(s) or Pole clearing crews
Tree Maintenance	Annual	Tree crews
Chemical Maintenance	Annual	Tree growth regulator applicators and herbicide application crews

### Post-Audits

PacifiCorp conducts post-audits to ensure vegetation maintenance actions conforms with required scope and standards.

Post-audits are conducted by PacifiCorp staff or third-party contractors.

Vegetation maintenance actions, sample size, and audit types, that are targeted for post-audits are presented in **Table 2**.

## **Documentation and Contractor Coordination**

QC actions are documented electronically and reviewed with contract management to drive continuous improvement.
